BTECs



Recommendations:

- Breaking down the glass ceiling: only 15 BTEC students were accepted at the 4 most selective institutions in 2015 <u>AND</u> under 60% of students with BTECs at Russell Group institutions complete their course.
- Considering bespoke access courses to facilitate adjustment.
