#### Setting of the research

- Niche provider, associate faculty of post-1992 university
- Applied science and business management Fd, BSc and M programmes – Animal and Land, Sports, Equine
- Also Veterinary Nursing provision- RCVS accredited
- FE provision mirrors HE provision in key areas through BTEC and Access to HE programmes



#### Why was this a project of interest?

Limited published research in similar settings

Initial motivation- so why not follow through?

Can different support be provided?



#### Approach

Questionnaire- administered by phone and linked into ongoing marketing activities

 Identified internal students who had not been placed despite applying to HEIs


 Allows snap shot, currently working with sample in follow-up interviews



#### Participants

 Initially sample of 49, but some incomplete or out of date contact details

Final participants 30





## Initial Reasons for Rejection

Did not meet conditions of offer (at first choice)

Financial difficulties – main reason

 Travelling over HE studies- deferred entry to 2017 or 2018

Job promotion- but considering p/t return in 2018



## Initial reasons for Rejection


Chose apprenticeship over HE- earning while learning

 Professional sporting career, although considering return to related programme for 2020/2021 entry




#### Main barriers by Gender and Age (n)

### Considerations for future HE entry


 4 planning to enrol in either 2017 or 2018 (accepted)

#### Preliminary conclusions and thoughts

- Definitely requires further work- wider collaboration between FE colleges?
- Could have considered wider WP characteristics-future research
- Lack of understanding of HE as a whole- benefits and purposes need to be promoted more clearly
- Need more flexible and / or WB provision in wider range of areas.
