



Learning



- Planning takes longer than you expect!
- Managing of expectations what is realistic.
- Listen to young people (and act on what we hear)
- Give a framework/guidance/brief to young people
- Adds kudos & credibility to activity
- Improves parental engagement
- Evaluation can't be an afterthought.
