What did we learn?

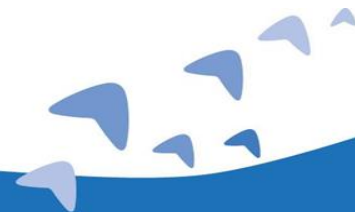
Needs to be Year 10
