Derby context – APP target groups (gaps)

- Continuation (6.6pp), degree outcomes (16.3pp) and progression (6.6pp) between white and black students
- Continuation (6.8pp) and degree outcomes between students from IMD quintiles 5 and 1 (13.0pp)
- Degree outcomes between disabled and non-disabled students (4.5pp)
- Progression between white and asian students (6.6pp)

- 1b. Eliminate unexplained gaps in degree outcomes between white and black students.
- 1c. Eliminate unexplained gaps in progression between white and black students.
- 2a. Eliminate unexplained gaps in continuation* between students from IMD quintile 5 and 1.
- 2b. Eliminate the gaps in degree outcomes between students from IMD quintile 5 and 1.
- 3. Eliminate the gaps in degree outcomes between no known disability and disabled students.
- 4. Eliminate unexplained gaps in progression between white and asian students.

Each individual measurable objective is shown on a different tab in this workbook.

This workbook is designed to support institutional monitoring of these specific measurables and enable further in depth exploration of the data.

*Continuation figures in this workbook may differ slightly from the OfS published data. In this dataset students who transfer to another HEI are classed as non-continuers whereas in the official OfS data they are classed as continuers.




APP dashboard – table view (College)
