
#### Working with primary aged children - The survey

- School availability and staff cover especially for on campus events, leading to cancellation at late notice and occasional poor attendance.

- Convincing some other staff of its relevance






#### Local issues

- Little support for transition to secondary available at local secondary schools.
- issues of excellent primaries feeding into underfunded struggling secondary schools.
- first generation immigrant and refugee students
- Financial disadvantage








